**SUBJECT: Control and Enforcement of Parking Restriction**

Policy:

1. Residents may park their vehicles in the area adjacent to the boat ramp while conducting business at the association office, using the pier, in conjunction with the use of the boat ramp, or for personal reasons from time to time as long as the time does not exceed two (2) hours per day. Vehicle permits must be displayed at all times. Under no circumstances will personal vehicles be permitted to park in this area overnight.
2. Boat trailers may be parked in this area provided that they do not interfere with traffic flow and are removed by sundown. Under no circumstances will boat trailers be permitted to park in this area overnight.
3. Guests of residents may use this parking area as long as the vehicle permit is displayed in the vehicle.
4. The Board shall provide each owner with a Guest Parking Pass that must be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle when utilizing parking spaces at the Clubhouse or pier.
5. Parking on the street or on grass is prohibited. Residents may park their vehicles at clubhouse while using pool, beach, or clubhouse with a daily three (3) hour limit. Guests may exceed the three (3) hour limit as long as they are visiting a resident. Residents may not use clubhouse or pier parking areas as auxiliary parking for personal vehicles.
