SUBJECT: Respectful Display of the U. S. Flag

The Association has no objection to owners wishing to display the U. S. flag; however, the Association believes that owners wishing to display the U. S. flag should do so in a respectful manner and adhere to Federal, State, and Local codes, rules, and regulations in regards to displaying the U. S. flag.

POLICY:

1. Flags must be displayed in accordance with the standards as established by the U. S. Congressional Code in 1942, including but not limited to, flying the flag in the open from sunrise to sunset. It should be raised briskly and lowered ceremoniously. No other flag or pennant should be placed above the U. S. flag. Owners displaying flags shall adhere to all Federal, State, and Local codes, rules or regulations, addressing the display of the U. S. flag.
2. Flag poles may not be installed in such a manner that when the flag is displayed the flag obstructs the sidewalks and/or roads in any way.
3. Maintenance of the mounting bracket shall be the owner's responsibility. This includes, but is not limited to, replacing screws if they are rusted and touching up paint if it is discolored by rusting mounting screws. If the owner fails to properly maintain the bracket and the Association repairs any damage done to the outside of the building the owner shall pay all costs associated with said repairs.
